Travel and Lodging Information

All Participants:

- The program will cover the cost of meals and accommodations at the UCLA Lake Arrowhead Conference Center for two nights, Friday, April 19 and Saturday, April 20. Check-in begins at 4:00 pm on Friday. The program ends at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- Please be aware that when you register for the retreat, the program must guarantee your attendance 30 days in advance with the conference center.
- If you register and then do not attend, the program must pay the full amount for your room and board.

Instructions for Air Travelers (Northern California):

- All participants are responsible for arranging their own air travel. Please register and book your air travel reservations soon to make travel arrangements at the lowest possible fares. Please note that we will arrive at Ontario International (ONT) Airport on April 19 and depart from Ontario Airport (ONT) on April 20.
- All participants arriving by air are invited to use the free charter bus to the
 conference center provided by PPFP. PPFP will not reimburse rental cars or
 other individual shuttle transportation from the airport to the conference
 center. Shuttles will be scheduled for participants returning to Sacramento or
 San Francisco.
- All other expenses associated with air travel (i.e. airport parking and mileage to airport) will be reimbursed in accordance with the instructions for ground travelers below.

 Participants traveling at times other than the flight times listed on the online registration form are responsible for arranging their own ground transportation.

Instructions for Ground Travelers (Southern California):

- President's and Chancellor's Postdoctoral Fellows and Faculty Mentors: Ground travel expenses are covered by the fellows' research and travel grants.
 Supplemental funds have been transferred to the department for this purpose.
 Requests for reimbursement for travel should be submitted directly to the home department. Please carpool if possible to conserve your travel funds!

 Form, provided at the retreat along with original receipts to Program Assistant
